Case Study of Road Traffic Problem in Pune City

Introduction:

Pune Municipal corporation in the document on smart city stated that, the city aspires to become global urban centre. But yearly environment status report of Pune Municipal Corporation reported Pune is witnessing alarming rise in the level of air and noise pollution. The vehicle density is 753 vehicles per 1000 people. "Traffic that does not seem to move on city's roads is a common picture. And while absence of mass transport is main cause of the traffic mess, city's threadbare infrastructure is also a culprit, adding to the woes of city commuters. With 450 square kilometres of area after the proposed merger of 34 villagers from surrounding areas, Pune is set to become one of the largest cities in India. The population of Pune, Pimpri-Chinchwad and adjoining cantonments has already touched 55 lakh and is expected to grow one crore by 2030." (1)

Objective of Study:

1. To study the awareness of traffic rules among the police.
2. To understand the importance of traffic rules.

Statement of Problem:

Now a days people who lives in Pune and in cities like Pune face many problems regarding traffic and pollution. Traffic problems have multiplies due to increase in number of two, three and four wheelers on the roads and the speeding.

Background of Survey:

We met DCP Mr. Pankaj Deshmukh for NOC (No Objection Certificate). All the above stated officers were cordial and supportive in the execution of our project.

When I put forth the idea, the Founder President of BEF (Business Ethics Foundation) Dr. S.G. Bapat directed me on how to develop the project undertaken? The project was then finalized after three/four meetings with Dr. S.G. Bapat.

We used survey method for our project two questionnaires: one for the citizens and another for the police were formed. 10 multiple choice questions were included in each.

I approached BEF member Assistant Prof. Dr. Rupali Sheth working in Huzurpaga Mahila Vanijya Mahavidalaya as per suggestion of Dr. S.G. Bapat and Principal Y. R. Thorat permitted us to take assistance of students of NSS. Some students of the Huzurpaga Mahila Vanijya Mahavidyalaya got the questionnaires filled from 468 citizens and 27 traffic policemen.

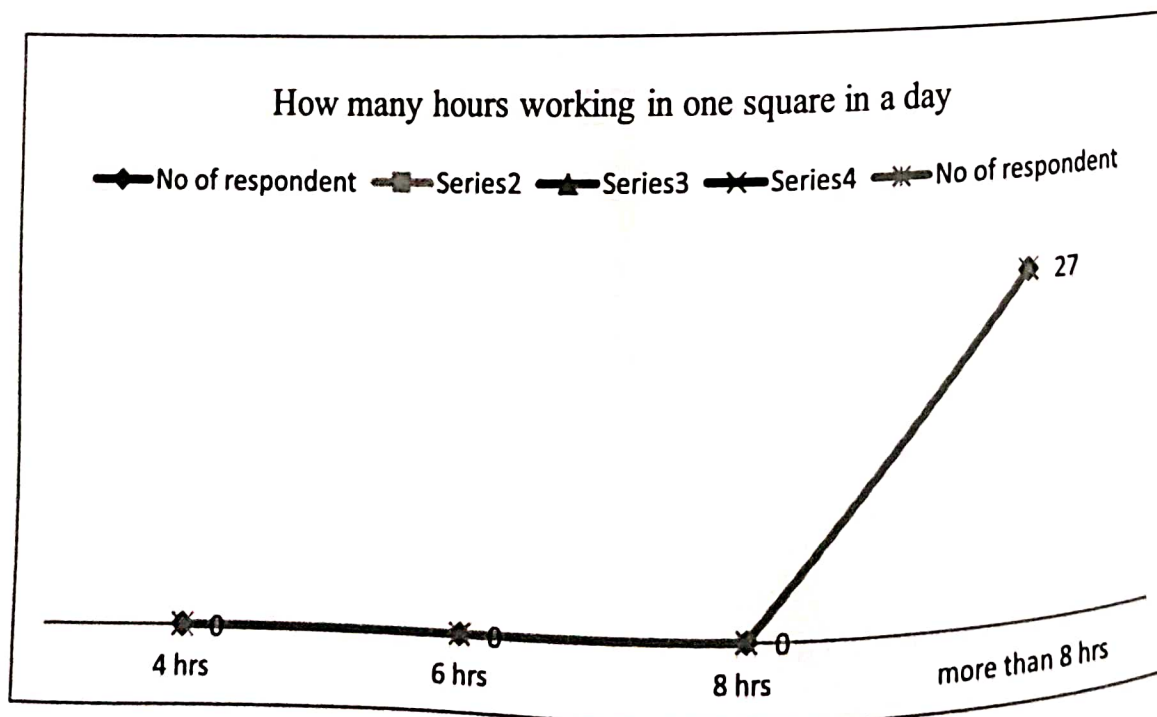
Data Analysis:

We collected data from the police personnel working at various squares, in two weeks through the students of Huzurpaga Mahila Vanijya Mahavidalaya. The squares selected for surveys were Kothrud, SNTD, Paud Phata, Budhwar Chauk, Varje Juction, Varje Malwadi, Wireless Wadgaon Chawk, Cummins Chawk, Rajaram Chawk, Ambedkar chawk, Lavle Bridge, Ogle chawk, karve Putala Kothrud.

Total survey covered, 27 policemen from the centres.

Part I (Survey of Traffic Police)

1. How many hours working in one square in a day?



100% respondents said that they work in one square in one day for more than 8 hours which is shown by diagram
